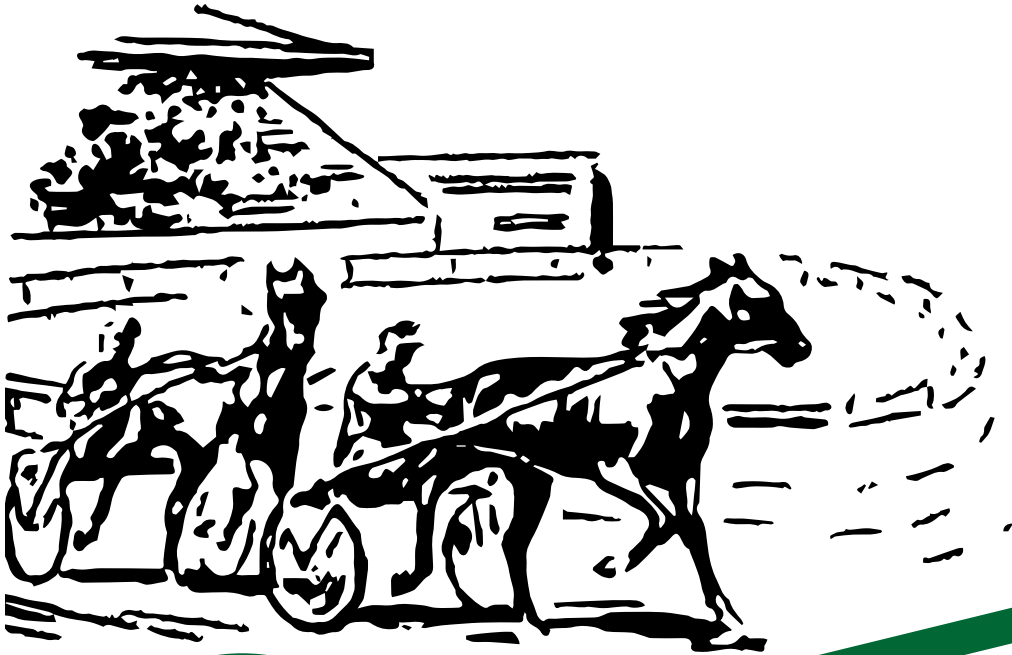

Harness Racing GLOSSARY OF TERMS

BOXED IN: A horse that is racing on the rail and is surrounded by other horses in front, outside and behind it. A horse that is boxed in is held up and unable to gain a clear passage.

BREAK: To start galloping and lose the natural trotting or pacing rhythm. This occurs more often with trotters than pacers.

CARD: Another term for a program of racing. For example, a person may refer to there being twelve races on the card, which simply means twelve races will be staged on that particular day.

CATCH DRIVER: A driver which does not train his or her own horses and is engaged by other trainers to drive their horses.

CLAIMING RACE: A race where any of the entrants may be claimed (purchased) for a specified amount.

COLORS: The colorful suit (also called "silks") worn by drivers/trainers. Unlike Thoroughbred racing, the drivers/trainers register their own colors and wear them every time they race.

COLT: A male 3 years of age or less.

CONDITIONED RACE: A race where eligibility is based on age, sex, money won, or races won. For example, "3-year-old colts who are non-winners of \$10,000 lifetime or 4 races."

COVER: A horse that races with another horse in front of him is said to race with cover, as the leading horse cuts the wind resistance.

DEAD HEAT: A situation in which the judges cannot separate two or more horses when judging the outcome of a race. This race is declared a tie (Dead Heat).

DISTANCED: A horse that is out of touch with the rest of the field at the end of the race. This is often referred to as "finished distanced".

FIRST-OVER: The first horse to make a move on the leader in a race, moving up on the outside.

FREE LEGGED: A pacer which races without wearing hobbles.

HOME STRETCH: The straight length of the track, nearest the spectators, heading toward the finish line. It is called this because it is the final part of the track a horse travels down on its way 'home' (or the finish line).

HOPPLES: The straps which connect the front and rear legs on the same side of a horse. Most pacers wear hobbles to help balance their stride and maintain a pacing gait. The length of hobbles is adjustable and a trainer registers the length that best suits his or her horse. There are also trotting hobbles that work through a pulley system to help trotters maintain their gait.

INQUIRY: Judging officials may conduct an inquiry as a result of any incident which may have occurred during a race, to determine whether or not certain drivers and/or horses were responsible for the incident.

PACER: Are horses whose legs move in a lateral motion, meaning the two legs on the same side of the body move in unison. For example, both right legs move forward as both left legs are going back.

PARKED: A horse racing on the outside, with at least one horse between it and the inside rail.

PHOTO FINISH: When two horses cross the finish line too closely to identify a winner, officials call for a photograph of the race, taken exactly at the finish line, to help them determine which nose is ahead.

POCKET: A horse in a pocket is unable to obtain a clear path because it has other horses situated in front, behind and to the side of it.

POST TIME: Start of the race.

QUALIFIER: A race in which a horse must contest a mile below an established time standard to prove itself capable of competing in pari-mutuel races.

STANDARD BRED: The breed of horse which competes in harness races.

SULKY: Also known as the cart or racebike, the sulky is attached to the harness and carries the driver.

TOTE BOARD: An electronic board, usually in the infield of a track, which posts the odds, amount of money bet, results of a race and the wagering pay-offs.

TROTTER: Horses whose legs on the opposite side of the body move at the same time. For example, the right front and left rear move forward as the left front and right rear move back.

General Operations

Supervision of the pari-mutuel betting and drug control services is provided by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA), a division of Agriculture Canada, the Honourable Lawrence MacAulay M.P. All pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with these Regulations. All tickets shall be held until the result of the race is declared official. No minor shall purchase or cash a pari-mutuel ticket. Approximate odds represent the probable pay-out price of the win pool at the time they are posted and have no bearing on the pay-out price for any other pool. Where approximate odds for any horse are posted as "1-9", the pay-out price based on a \$2 bet on the win pool may be as low as \$2.10. All tickets should be kept until the result of the race is declared official. No ruling made by the Judges or the Alcohol And Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools. In the case of foreign separate pool betting, the rules of racing are those of the governing body that regulates the race.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that cancellation of races should result for any reason after four races have been run in any day's program, no refunds or issuance of rain checks will be made. If a cancellation results before the completion of four races, rain checks will be issued for admission and upon producing the day's Official Program at the program seller's booth, a next day's racing program will be exchanged. Under no circumstances will money be refunded.

Refunds

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, all monies bet in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is canceled, declared off, declared no contest or postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled. Subject to the Regulations, all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. Where a horse that is part of an entry is a late scratch and at least one horse of that entry or mutual field starts in the race, all tickets purchased on that entry or mutual field remain valid, and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

Fair Start

The starter shall have control of the horses from the formation of the post parade until a start has been determined. For purpose of this rule, the determination of the start is when the horses have passed the starting point and have been released by the starter. 22.03 (h) There shall be no recall after the horses have been released by the starter. 22.03 (i) The starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and on gait. The starter shall only sound a recall for the following reasons: (i) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate; (ii) There is interference before the horses have reached the starting point; (iii) A horse has broken equipment, which the starter notices; (iv) A horse falls before the starting point; (v) A horse coming to the starting gate in the wrong position; (vi) A malfunction of the starting gate or in the interests of safety. 22.03 (l) If a horse has not reached the Fair Start Pole when the horses are released at the starting point by the starter, the judges shall cause the "inquiry" sign to be displayed immediately.

Breaking Rule

When a horse breaks from its gait in a race the driver shall: (a) take the horse to the outside of other horses where clearance exists and; (b) properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait; (c) lose ground while on the break. If there has been no violation of (a), (b) or (c) above, the horse shall not be set back unless a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, if interference caused by another driver(s) or horse(s) has caused the horse to be on a break at the finish, the judges may, in their discretion determine not to set the horse back even if a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish. The judges may set any horse back one or more places if, in their judgment, any of the above violations have been committed, or if the horse goes on an extended break, and the driver may be penalized.

Entry or Field in an Exactor

Exactor pools on races that have an entry (1 and 1A and/or 2 and 2B) or mutual field (14f, 15f...) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest (ie. 1-1, 2-2, field-field). If the same betting interest finishes first and second, the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

Win, Place, Show Betting

Available on every race unless otherwise posted.

Daily Double & Late Double Betting

Where the daily double feature is operated, the daily double is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double and that if the purchaser of a daily double ticket fails to pick the winner of the first half of the daily double his bet is void and that all tickets in the second half of the daily double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the daily double are void no matter what circumstances might affect the programmed running of the second half of the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holders of all daily double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the daily double race, shall participate in the Consolation Double pool.

Exactor Betting

Where the exactor feature is operated, the exactor is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses to finish, in the exact order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Triactor Betting

A Triactor bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Pick-3 or Pick-4 Betting

The Pick-3 and Pick-4 features are betting transactions in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of three or four consecutive races on which the Pick-3 or Pick-4 is scheduled to be run. The winning combination of horses constituting a winning ticket shall be those horses that finish first, in the official order of finish in each leg or feature. Where no tickets have been sold coupling horses finishing first in the official order of finish of each leg of the pool, winning tickets shall be determined in the following sequence: Pick-3: (a) the winner of two legs; (b) the winner of one leg; (c) the three horses finishing second; (d) sequentially thereafter. Pick-4: (a) the winner of three legs; (b) the winner of two legs; (c) one winner of one leg; (d) the four horses finishing second; (e) sequentially thereafter. Pick-3 or Pick-4 Scratches: Rule 11 (1). In the event a Pick-3 or Pick-4 feature ticket designates as a selection in any one or more of the races comprising the Pick-3 or Pick-4, a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in the race, the favorite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch(s) occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection for all purposes. (2) In the event that the money bet in the win pool for (2) two or more favorites is identical, the selection identified in the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

Pari-Mutuel Deductions

In Win, Place, Show, pools, 21.3%, Exactor pools, 21.3% is retained by the Association, 2.0% for Provincial Levy, 0.5% by the Ontario Government and 0.8% by the Federal Government.

In Triactor pools 21.3% is retained by the Association, 4.0% Provincial Levy, 0.5% by the Ontario Government and 0.8% by the Federal Government. In Pick 3 and Pick 4 pools 21.3% is retained by the Association, 4.0% Provincial Levy, 0.5% by the Ontario Government and 0.8% by the Federal Government

Allowances

2-year-old fillies 100%; 2-year-old colts & geldings 75%; 3-year-old fillies 75%; 3-year-old colts & geldings 50%; 4-year-old mares 50%; 4-year-old horses & geldings 25%; 5-year-old mares 25%; Spayed mares and mares 6 years or older receive no allowance. In the case of a claimed horse, said horse need not necessarily increase its claiming price to be eligible to future claiming events.

Common Pool Wagering

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, in the unlikely event of a communications or computer systems failure, various courses of action may result depending on the nature of the breakdown. Bets from the affected sites, including advance bets, may be considered as a separate pool or may even be refunded in the event of a complete system failure. Changing a site's bets from common pool to separate pool may affect the odds and prices. Customers will be advised by public announcement of the course of action taken.

Rule 7.15

No association shall allow a person under 18 years of age to purchase or cash a ticket. For the purposes of this rule, a "ticket" is defined as a receipt or voucher that is issued by an association for one or more bets on a race or races. The association shall ensure that signs are clearly posted in all areas, or in application forms, where tickets are purchased or cashed, advising the public of the age restriction.

Advance Notice Of New Bet Cancellation Options

The Pari-Mutuel Betting Supervision Regulations are being amended to provide the public, when authorized by an Agency Officer of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, the option to cancel or retain bets in the following situations after betting has opened. These situations are listed below:

a) when part of an entry or mutual field is scratched; b) when there is a change in the type of racing surface; c) when the distance of the race changes; d) early bets made thirty minutes before the post time of the first race and, in every other case, before the judges or stewards, declare as official, the previous race of the card.

NEW RULES IN EFFECT
